Join the 11th Annual Cardboard Sled Derby & BBQ

Sunday, March 18th 2007; Registration 9:30 am; Race 10:30 am; BBQ 11-1:30

Located on the Telluride Ski and Golf tubing hill

One to One, San Miguel Mentoring Program's Cardboard Sled Derby and BBQ is for all school-aged children, ages 5-17. There are three categories for the winners: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for race winners, speed winners and creativity winners. All participants receive a consolation prize and the place winners receive trophies. You can attain a registration form from your school secretary or One to One. All registration and liability forms must be returned to the school secretary or One to One by March 15th.

Last year, over 100 kids raced down the tubing hill. The sleds are made by using only cardboard, string, paper, tape, glue and paint, and then put to the test on the race hill. The BBQ following the race is free to all participants in the derby, \$10 for adults and \$5 for non-participating children and mentors.

Rules and Requirements

- Participants can only be on one sled team. Open to school-aged children ages 5-17
- In order to participate each team member **MUST** have a completed Waiver and Release Form signed by their parent or guardian.
- Sled may be made only of cardboard, tape, paper, glue, string and paint. No metal tape is allowed.
- Waxing optional
- Participants are required to wear helmets, goggles, gloves, long sleeves, and long pants.
- No parents will be allowed at the starting line area
- Sleds must have a minimum of 6 inches in front, back, and 2 sides
